



**EXHIBIT C2- PROVISIONS FOR THE INTRASTATE TRANSIT OF
BULK CITRUS AND OTHER REGULATED ARTICLES INTENDED FOR CONSUMPTION
THROUGH NON-CONTIGUOUS
ASIAN CITRUS PSYLLID QUARANTINE AREAS**

1. Establishment **MUST** be under compliance with the Asian citrus psyllid (ACP) Project and must follow **ALL** stipulations outlined in each applicable Compliance Agreement Exhibit C-F and each additional applicable Exhibit.
2. Establishment shall only move regulated articles from one ACP quarantine area to another, through a non-contiguous quarantine area when following **ALL** stipulations listed below:
 - a. **Transport**
All bulk citrus may only be transported, without undue delay, between quarantine areas in completely enclosed conveyances.
 - b. **Pest Exposure**
The conveyance shall not be opened nor shall the bulk citrus be exposed to the environment while outside the quarantine area.
 - c. **Approved Route**
The transit corridor thru the unregulated area shall be as specified in the “Special Instructions” below.
 - d. **Washing of Transport Conveyance and Bins**
Immediately after unloading the bulk citrus shipment, the entire transport conveyance and all used packing equipment (bins, barrels, containers, etc.) used for transport must be completely washed and/or rinsed inside and out at the site of delivery to ensure the removal of all possible transported ACP.
 - e. **Spill Notification**
Establishment shall notify the ACP Project and receiving establishment as soon as possible and no later than 24 hours in the event of an accident or spillage of the regulated shipment.
3. **Infested Bulk Citrus**
If the bulk citrus is found to be infested with ACP, Establishment shall immediately notify the Project and refrain from moving any bulk citrus from the Establishment until the Project determines movement can commence.
4. **Other Regulated Articles Intended for Consumption**
Other regulated articles intended for consumption (i.e. kaffir lime leaves) may be handled in the same manner as bulk citrus under this exhibit and compliance agreement.
