



EXHIBIT C- PACKER/PROCESSOR/HANDLER LOCATED INSIDE THE ASIAN CITRUS PSYLLID QUARANTINE AREA

PROVISIONS FOR THE INTRASTATE SHIPMENT OF ASIAN CITRUS PSYLLID HOST FRUIT OR MATERIAL SHIPPED FROM AREAS QUARANTINED FOR ASIAN CITRUS PSYLLID

To Be Used With:

- QC Permit 1255 (Bulk Citrus)
- QC Permit 1306 (Processed Host Material)

1. Cleaning Process

- A) All **fruit** must be subjected to a process to wash and/or remove leaf and stem debris prior to leaving the ACP quarantined area.
- B) All ACP **host material**, other than fruit, must complete a Project approved process.

2. Records

Establishment must maintain records of all ACP host material shipments leaving the quarantine area and must make records available to agriculture inspectors immediately upon request.

3. Evidence of Compliance for Field Cleaned Fruit or Host Material

- A) Field cleaned **fruit** moved directly out of the ACP quarantine area must be accompanied by a Field Cleaning Verification Form.
- B) All ACP **host material**, other than fruit, moved directly out of the ACP quarantine area must be accompanied by a Project approved Processing Checklist.

4. Trapping and Inspection

Establishment shall allow agricultural officials to inspect the premises to ensure compliance with this agreement, obtain and review records of all shipments destined to locations outside the ACP quarantine area, and place and service traps for the detection of ACP.

5. Training

Establishment shall ensure all employees receive training to be compliant with all specifications of this compliance agreement exhibit.

6. Information posting

Establishment shall place informative posters and associated ACP information supplied by the ACP Project in a conspicuous location.
