



## EXHIBIT F- TRANSPORTER/HAULER- CITRUS FRUIT

### PROVISIONS FOR THE INTRASTATE SHIPMENT OF ALL CITRUS OR OTHER ASIAN CITRUS PSYLLID HOST FRUIT SHIPPED FROM AREAS QUARANTINED FOR ASIAN CITRUS PSYLLID

#### WHEN TRANSPORTING/HAULING SHIPMENTS OF BULK CITRUS OR OTHER ASIAN PSYLLID HOST FRUIT, FROM ACP QUARANTINED AREAS, THE ESTABLISHMENT SHALL:

**1. Approved Sourcing**

Only transport shipments from an establishment under compliance with the ACP Project.

**2. Approved Receiving Facility**

Ensure all shipments delivered outside the ACP quarantine area are received by packers/processors/receivers under compliance with the receiving County Agricultural Commissioner.

*The ACP Project will provide a list of packers/processors/receivers located **outside** of the ACP quarantine area under compliance with the receiving County Agricultural Commissioner.*

**3. Direct Route**

Take the most *continuous, direct route, without interruption* to the approved receiver.

**4. Transport Cleanliness**

Ensure that the vehicle and/or trailer used for transporting is free from all leaf and stem debris and free of all life stages of ACP prior to transport and after delivery.

**5. Evidence of Compliance**

Place a copy of the compliance agreement and this exhibit in EACH transport vehicle.

**6. Records**

Maintain shipping records for a minimum of two years and provide such records to the ACP Project upon request.

**7. Training**

Ensure all employees receive training to be compliant with all specifications of this compliance agreement exhibit.

**8. Spill notification**

Notify the ACP Project as soon as possible and no later than 24 hours after spillage of any shipment.
