APPLES & GRAPES -

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

AD Required:

“The shipment has been inspected and found free of pink hibiscus mealybug, ((MACONELLICOCCLUS HIRSUTUS) (Green)) and originated in an area free from the insect.”

ONIONS & ONION SEED-

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

Shipments must be free from soil and packed in new cartons.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phytosanitary certificates must be legible and accurate with no alterations or erasures. Inspections must be done within 30 days of shipping. NOTE: Import Permits are valid only for a period of 30 days from issuance. This validity may be extended only for an additional 30 days. IP’s must be obtained in advance of shipment.

SUMMARY INFO -

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. Fruit is Prohibited from states where *Diplodea spp.* (Fungal disease of Prunus) is known to occur.

DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.

Diplodea spp. has been known to occur in CA.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phytosanitary certificates must be legible and accurate with no alterations or erasures. Inspections must be done within 30 days of shipping. NOTE: Import Permits are valid only for a period of 30 days from issuance. This validity may be extended only for an additional 30 days. IP's must be obtained in advance of shipment.

SUMMARY INFO - BALED COTTON ORIGINATING FROM AREAS WHICH ARE REGULATED FOR PINK BOLLWORM (*Pectinophora gossypiella*) – (Kern County is regulated for pink bollworm)

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

AD Required:

“The product has been inspected and found free of *Pectinophora gossypiella*. The shipment has been inspected and found free of pink hibiscus mealybug, ((*MACONELLICOCCUS HIRSUTUS*) (Green)) and originated in an area free from the insect.”

THE COTTON MUST BE TREATED WITH ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TREATMENTS:

- 1) Bales compressed to at least 22 p/ft³
- 2) Fumigated with Methyl Bromide at a dosage rate of 3lbs/1000ft³ for 24 hrs

The treatment must be recorded in the treatment section of the phytosanitary certificate.

Phone the main office for information about certifying baled cotton from areas where pink bollworm is not known to occur.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phytosanitary certificates must be legible and accurate with no alterations or erasures. Inspections must be done within 30 days of shipping. NOTE: Import Permits are valid only for a period of 30 days from issuance. This validity may be extended only for an additional 30 days. IP's must be obtained in advance of shipment.

SUMMARY INFO -

FRUIT – (from CA)

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required.

Fruit is prohibited from all states where *Ceratitis capitata* (Medfly) or *Dacus dorsalis* (Oriental fruit fly) is known to occur. Must be free from soil. Note: California has several counties with infestations of Med fly. Therefore: **DO NOT CERTIFY unless an import permit (translated into English) has been presented.** Use the AD stated on the import Permit as well as:

AD Required: “The shipment has been inspected and found free of pink hibiscus mealybug ((MACONELLICOCCUS HIRSUTUS (Green)) and originated in an area free from the insect.”

SEED – Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.**

PLANTS, PLANT PARTS- Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.**

AD Required: “ “The shipment has been inspected and found free of pink hibiscus mealybug ((MACONELLICOCCUS HIRSUTUS (Green)) and originated in an area free from the insect.”

Plants, Plant Parts, & Seeds are prohibited from all states were citrus tristeza (Quick decline), a virus disease whose vector is *Aphis citricidus* (the citrus aphid), or where *Xanthomonas citri* (citrus canker) is known to occur. Must be free from soil.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phytosanitary certificates must be legible and accurate with no alterations or erasures. Inspections must be done within 30 days of shipping. NOTE: Import Permits are valid only for a period of 30 days from issuance. This validity may be extended only for an additional 30 days. IP’s must be obtained in advance of shipment.

SUMMARY INFO -

For consumption:Phytosanitary certificate & Import Permit are required.

AD Required: "The shipment is found free of quarantine pest for EL Salvadore: *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Globodera rostochiensis*, *Globodera tabacum*, *Nacobbus aberrans*, *Phytophthora erythroseptica* var *Erythroseptica*, and *Ralstonia solanacearum* race 3. The potatoes were grown and packed in the U.S. The potatoes come from a production area inspected during the active growing season, harvest, and packing. The potatoes were washed or brushed and treated with a bud tuber sprouting inhibitor."

For propagation:Phytosanitary certificate & Import Permit are required.

AD Required: "The shipment is found free of quarantine pest for EL Salvadore: *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Globodera rostochiensis*, *Globodera tabacum*, *Nacobbus aberrans*, *Phytophthora erythroseptica* var *Erythroseptica*, and *Ralstonia solanacearum* race 3. The potatoes were grown and packed in the U.S. The potatoes come from a production area inspected during the active growing season, harvest, and packing.

NOTE: Review Import Permit if presented for any additional information.

Pratylenchus Penetrans is a pest that has been listed on the IP but is not in PeXD, if IP is presented and Pratylenchus Penetrans is listed make sure to add Pratylenchus Penetrans to additional declaration.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phytosanitary certificates must be legible and accurate with no alterations or erasures. Inspections must be done within 30 days of shipping. NOTE: Import Permits are valid only for a period of 30 days from issuance. This validity may be extended only for an additional 30 days. IP's must be obtained in advance of shipment.
