SUMMARY INFO -

ALL FRUIT (Except Grapes) -

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. Must be free from *Ceratitis capitata* (Medfly), *Bactrocera spp.* (Fruit flies), and *Quadraspidiotus perniciosus* (= *Aspidiotus perniciosus*) (San Jose scale). Fruit must be clean and free of plant debris.

AD Required:

“The product is free from BACTROCERA SPP., CERATITIS CAPITATA, and QUADRASPIDIOTUS PERNICIOSUS.”

GRAPES –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. In addition to the pests listed above, grapes must also be free from *Cochylis spp.* (Vine moth). Fruit must be free of leaves. Bearer peduncles (Main stalk of the bunch) must be less than 1cm in diameter.

AD Required (GRAPES):

From California - Areas regulated and not regulated for *Bactrocera spp.*, *Ceratitis capitata*, and *Homalodisca coagulata* require the following AD. Kern is not regulated for *Bactrocera spp.* or *Ceratitis capitata*, but certain areas of the county are regulated for *Homalodisca coagulata* (GWSS). You must look at map to determine whether fruit originated in regulated area (<http://apps4.cdfa.ca.gov/PiercesMaps/Default.aspx>). If fruit originates in regulated area, treatment (MB fumigation) is required.

“The product is free from *Bactrocera spp.*, *Ceratitis capitata*, *Cochylis spp.*, *Homalodisca coagulata*, and *Quadraspidiotus perniciosus*.”

AD Required:

“The product is free from BACTROCERA SPP., CERATITIS CAPITATA, and FRANKLINIELLA OCCIDENTALIS.’

Treatment is required for products from regulated areas for *Bactrocera spp.* and *Ceratitis capitata*. Kern County is NOT regulated for these pests.

AD Required:

Xanthomonas campestris pv *aurantifolia* and *Xanthomonas campestris* pv *citri* are not known to occur in the area of origin. *Phaeoramularia angolensis* is not known to occur in the area of origin. *Guignardia citricarpa* is not known to occur in the area of origin. The product is free from *Quadraspidiotus perniciosus*, *Scirtothrips aurantii* and *Scirtothrips citri*. The area of origin is officially recognized as free of *Bactrocera spp.* and *Ceratitis capitata*.

PLANTS AND SEED -

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.**

BALED COTTON –

Baled cotton is Unrestricted. You may issue a Federal Phytosanitary Certificate upon request.

COTTON SEED –

Cotton seed is Prohibited. Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.**

Phyto Inspections must take place within 30 days of shipment. French Polynesia requires that Phyto certificates not be issued more than (5) days prior to the shipping date.

SUMMARY INFO -

VEGETABLES -

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. Must be free of *Delia Antigua* (Onion maggot), *Peronospora destructor* (Onion downy mildew), and *Urocystis cepulae* (Onion smut).

AD Required:

“The product is free from DELIA ANTIGUA, PERONOSPORA DESTRUCTOR, and UROCYSTIS CEPULAE.”

Must be free from soil.

SEED (From CA & FL) –

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. Must be free from *Peronospora destructor* (Downy mildew), *Urocystis cepulae* (Onion smut), *Pratylenchus spp.* (Nematodes), and *Ditylenchus spp.* (Stem & Bulb nematode). Seed must be treated with an insecticide and fungicide with the treatment being written on the phyto.

AD Required:

“The product is free from PERONOSPORA DESTRUCTOR, UROCYSTIS CEPULAE, PRATYLENCHUS SPP., AND DITYLENCHUS SPP.”

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto Inspections must take place within 30 days of shipment. French Polynesia requires that Phyto certificates not be issued more than (5) days prior to the shipping date.

SUMMARY INFO -

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. Must be free from *Frankliniella occidentalis* (Western flower thrips), *Bemisia tabacii* (Sweet potato whitefly), and *Bactrocera spp.* (Fruit flies). Fruit must be clean and free of plant debris.

AD Required:

“The product is free from BACTROCERA SPP., FRANKLINIELLA OCCIDENTALIS, and BEMISIA TABACI.”

Treatment is required for products from regulated areas for *Bactrocera spp.* Kern County is NOT regulated for these pests.

PLANTS AND SEED -

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phyto Inspections must take place within 30 days of shipment. French Polynesia requires that Phyto certificates not be issued more than (5) days prior to the shipping date.

SUMMARY INFO – (from CA, FL, & HI)

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. Must be free from *Agrobacterium tumefaciens* (Crown gall), *Erwinia amylovora* (Fire blight), *Quadraspidiotus perniciosus* (= *Aspidiotus perniciosus*) (San Jose scale), Rose streak virus, and Rose wilt virus.

Plants MUST be treated with an insecticide and a fungicide. Treatment must be written on the Phyto.

AD Required:

“The product is free from AGROBACTERIUM TUMEFASCIENS, ERWINIA AMYLOVORA, QUADRASPIDIOTUS PERNICIOSUS, Rose Streak Virus, and Rose Wilt Virus.”

Soil alone or associated with plants including peat, compost, turf, sand, and manure are Prohibited from all countries.

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto Inspections must take place within 30 days of shipment. French Polynesia requires that Phyto certificates not be issued more than (5) days prior to the shipping date.
