SUMMARY INFO -

Import permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. All products must be free from soil.

No Additional declaration for: Almonds (*Prunus dulcis*), **Melons** (*Cucumis melo*), **Pistachios** (*Pistacia vera*), **Apricots** (*Prunus armeniaca*), **Kiwi** (*Actinidia chinensis*).

AD Required for the following:

- **Nectarines** (*Prunus persica* var. *nucipersica*) – “The shipment is free from *Grapholita molesta*.”
- **Plums** (*Prunus domestica*), “The shipment is free from *Conotrachelus nenuphar*, *Grapholita prunivora*, *Parlatorea oleae*,
- **Peaches** (*Prunus persica*)– “The shipment is free from *Conotrachelus nenuphar*, *Grapholita molesta*, *Parlatorea oleae*, and *Platynota stultana*.”
- **Pear** (*Pyrus communis*) – “This shipment is free of *Cydia pomonella*, *Hoplocampa hartig*, and *Pseudococcus calceolariae*.”
- **Apples** (*Malus domestica*)– “This shipment is free of *Grapholita prunivora*, *Lepidosaphes ulmi*, *Neonectria galligena*, *Pseudococcus calceolariae*, *Pseudococcus comstocki*, and *Schizothyrium pomi*.”

Grapes (*Vitis vinifera*) – Phyto and import permit are required.

Shipments of plants and plant products not accompanied by a PC may be imported only when they can be fumigated or disinfected at the expense of the importer to eliminate any pest risk.

CITRUS FRUIT –

AD Required: “The shipment is free of *Atherigona orientalis*.”

BUDS, CUTTINGS, TREES –

AD Required: “The material comes from certified nurseries free of *Candidatus liberibacter asiaticus*, *Ceroplastes rusci*, *Citrus cachexia viroid*, *Citrus exocortis viroid*, *Citrus huanglongbing disease*, *Citrus leprosis virus*, *Citrus psorosis virus*, *Citrus tristeza virus*, *Citrus variegated chlorosis*, *Diaprepes abbreviatus* and *Xanthomonas axonopodis pv. citri*.”

SEEDS-

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required.

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto Certificates must have no alterations or erasures. PC's must be visaed by a Guatemalan consul in the country of origin.

“The shipment is free of *Botryotinia allii*, *Burkholderia cepacia*, *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci* and *Stegobium paniceum*.”

ONION SEED -

AD Required:

“The shipment is free of *Botryotinia allii*, *Burkholderia cepacia*, *Cirsium arvense*, *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Imperata cylindrica* and *Stegobium paniceum*.”

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto Certificates must have no alterations or erasures. PC's must be visaed by a Guatemalan consul in the country of origin. Shipments of plants and plant products not accompanied by a PC may be imported only when they can be fumigated or disinfected at the expense of the importer to eliminate any pest risk.

AD Required: “The plants are in sterile culture media and were propagated by tissue culture technique.”

Tubers for consumption or processing:

AD Required: “The tubers were brushed. The shipment was treated with sprout inhibitor {*active ingredient*} at {*concentration*}. ”

Propagative material:

AD Required: “The shipment is free of *Alternaria radicina*, *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Meloidogyne chitwoodi*, *Phytophthora erythroseptica* var. *erythroseptica* and *Potato yellow dwarf virus*. ”

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto Certificates must have no alterations or erasures. PC's must be visaed by a Guatemalan consul in the country of origin. Shipments of plants and plant products not accompanied by a PC may be imported only when they can be fumigated or disinfected at the expense of the importer to eliminate any pest risk.
