AD: “The shipment comes from an area free from *Macconellicoccus hirsutus* (pink hibiscus mealybug).”

Plums & Nectarines

AD: “The shipment comes from an area free from *Macconellicoccus hirsutus* (pink hibiscus mealybug).”

Garlic-

AD: The shipment is free of *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Puccinia allii*, *Pratylenchus penetrans* and *Sclerotium cepivorum*.

Lemons:

AD: The shipment was inspected and found free of *Chalara elegans*.”

Tangerines

AD: The shipment is free of *Candidatus liberibacter asiaticus*. The shipment was inspected and found free of *Bactrocera dorsalis* and *Maconellicoccus hirsutus*.

Nicaragua continued:

Grapefruit

AD:"The shipment comes from an area free from *Macconellicoccus hirsutus* (pink hibiscus mealybug). The shipment is free of *Liberobacter asiaticus*."

Oranges:

AD: The shipment is free of *Candidatus liberibacter asiaticus*. The shipment was inspected and found free of *Bactrocera dorsalis* and *Maconellicoccus hirsutus*. The shipment is free of *Aonidiella aurantii*, *Dialeurodes citri* and *Penicillium italicum*.

SUMMARY INFO –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

Potatoes for Consumption -- Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) is required. Must be: free of soil and plant waste, treated with sprout inhibitor, and grown from certified seed potatoes.

AD Required: "The shipment has been inspected and found free of *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, and *Nacobbus aberrans*, and the potatoes were grown in a production site free of *Globodera rostochiensis*, and *Globodera pallida*,"

Seed Potatoes – Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) is required. Must be free from *Clavibacter michiganensis* subs. *Sepedonicus*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Globodera pallida*, *Globodera rostochiensis*, *Leptinotarsa decemlineata*, *Nacobbus aberrans*, and Potato yellow dwarf nucleohadovirus. Seed potatoes must comply with the seed potato certification program and be packed in new, clean containers (boxes, bags) with a certified seed potato tag attached. Shipment must be reasonably free of soil (at least 90% of the potatoes must have less than 10% of their surface covered with soil.

AD Required: "The potatoes in this shipment comply with the Protocol for the shipment of certified seed potatoes from the United States to Nicaragua. The shipment is free from *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Clavibacter michiganensis* subs. *Sepedonicus*, *Globodera rostochiensis*, *Globodera pallida*, *Nacobbus aberrans*, *Leptinotarsa decemlineata*, and Potato yellow dwarf nucleohadovirus."

For complete requirements, Contact the Ag Department for "*Protocol for the shipment of certified seed potatoes from the United States to Nicaragua*". As long as all provisions of the protocol are met, an Import Permit is **NOT** needed.
