SUMMARY INFO –

Shipments are subject to inspection upon arrival.

FRUIT -

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. Soil and plant pests are prohibited.

Melons and Squash – Treatment with broad-spectrum fungicide must be noted on the phyto, which required the treatment to be witnessed by an inspector.

PLANTS & PLANT PARTS –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. Must be free from soil, sand, and earth. Plants may be packed in a sterile medium such as peat, or a mixture of peat and biologically inert fillers such as perlite or vermiculite. Sterilization of the media must be officially supervised by a plant regulatory official and attested to on the Phyto Certificate. Please refer to your treatment manual for information concerning suggested treatments.

SEED –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required.

Treatment with broad-spectrum fungicide must be indicated on the Phyto Certificate.

NOTE: Shipments of Palm plants, grain, barley, wheat, and plants with soil attached should be researched in EXCERPT. Also, any plants imported for the celebration of any religious holiday except Islamic holidays are Prohibited (example: Christmas trees, etc.).

Phytosanitary Certificates must be accurate with no alterations or erasures.

SUMMARY INFO –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

Must be free from San Jose scale and other pests.

Must be free from soil, sand, and earth. Plants may be packed in a sterile artificial medium such as peat, or a mixture of peat and biologically inert fillers such as perlite or vermiculite. Sterilization of the media must be officially supervised by a plant regulatory official and attested to on the Phytosanitary Certificate. Phone the main office for treatment information.

Any plants imported for the celebration of any religious holiday except Islamic holidays are Prohibited (example: Christmas trees, etc.).

Phytosanitary Certificates must be accurate with no alterations or erasures.
