***CITRUS FRUIT** –Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required
The export of citrus fruit from California to Thailand is covered under a work plan called the Specific Commodity Understanding (SCU) #1. Interested parties should consult SCU #1 for specific details.

*Only the following fruits may be exported: Orange (including navels, tangerine, tangelos, valencias), Lemon (*C. limon*), Grapefruit (*C. x paradisi*), and Pummelo (*C. maxima*).

Quarantine pests: Medfly (*Ceratitis capitata*), Caribfly (*Anastrepha suspense*), Fullers rose beetle (*Pantomorus cervinus*), vectors of citrus diseases such as aphids (i.e. *Toxoptera aurantii*) and leafhoppers (*Circulifer tenellus* and *Scaphytopius nitrides*), and *Xanthomonas campestris pv. citrumelo*.

Fruit must be:

- From areas free from medfly and/or Caribfly
- Or subjected to mandatory cold treatment for Medfly or Caribfly infestation.
- The cold treatment may be done prior to shipment or in transit. Treatment must be noted on the Phyto. Refer to SCU #1 for details of the cold treatment.

NOTE: Packed boxes must be marked “For Thailand.” Shipping containers must be sealed and the seal numbers noted on the Phyto.

AD Required (no AD is required for seeds):

“This shipment is free from quarantine pests mentioned in paragraph 3.1 and 3.2 of SCU #1.”
