- Exporters should be cautioned that shipments may be delayed or held without the Control Certificate. **Do not** reference the Control Certificate on the Phytosanitary Certificate.

SUBSIDIARY INFO –Turkey has amended their time limit requirement for the issuance of phytosanitary certificates. The time limit between the inspection date of the commodity and the shipment date of the commodity may be no more than 14 (fourteen) days. Phytosanitary certificates may be issued post departure.

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate and Import Permit required.

Must be free from *Clavibacter michiganensis subs insidiosus*, *Ditylenchus dipsaci*, *Verticillium albo-atrum*, and *Verticillium dahliae*.

AD Required:

“The consignment complies with Annex IV 60.1 a of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.”

OR

“The consignment complies with Annex IV 60.1 b of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.”

AND

“The consignment complies with Annex IV 60.2 c of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.”

AND

“The consignment complies with Annex IV 60.2 d of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.”

AND

“The consignment complies with Annex IV 60.2 a of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.”

OR

“The consignment complies with Annex IV 60.2 b 1 of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.”

IMPORT PERMIT – Yes

RESTRICTIONS – Restricted

CITRUS SEED and **WATERMELON SEED** –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate and Import Permit required. Must be free from *Ditylenchus dipsaci*.

ONION SEED –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate and Import Permit required. Must be free from *Ditylenchus dipsaci* and *Sclerotium cepivorum*.

AD Required:

“No indications of disease caused by DITYLENCHUS DIPSACI were observed in the production area since the beginning of the vegetation period.”

Phone the main office, field inspection may be required.

SUBSIDIARY INFO – Turkey has amended their time limit requirement for the issuance of phytosanitary certificates. BOTANICAL NAME – *Gossypium spp.*

PRODUCT FORM – Fiber, Seed

PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT – No

RESTRICTIONS – Restricted

FIBER COTTON – Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

If the cotton fiber is not completely free from plant debris, seeds, seed debris, or other residues, then additional declaration 40.2 b must be used.

NOTE: For all baled cotton shipments certified to Turkey, both the number of bales and the (net) weight in kilograms must be listed in block 9 of the phyto.

AD Required: Use Annex AD only do not enter the red statement.

The consignment complies with Annex IV, **41.2 a**, of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.

(The baled or ginned cotton lint is free from plant and seed debris and residues)

OR

The consignment complies with Annex IV, **41.2 b**, of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey

(The baled or ginned cotton lint has been fumigated and there shall be evidence thereof by indicating the active ingredient, the minimum temperature, the rate (g/m³) and the exposure time (h) on the Phytosanitary Certificate)

SEED FOR PROPAGATION – Federal Phytosanitary Certificate and Import Permit required. Seeds must be free from GLOMERELLA GOSSYPHII, PECTINOPHORA GOSSYPHIELLA and XANTHOMONAS AXONOPOLIDIS PV MALVACEARUM.

AD Required: Use Annex AD only do not enter red statement

“The consignment complies with Annex IV, 41 a, of the Plant Quarantine Regulations of Turkey.”

(The seed has been acid delinted and no symptoms of *Glomerella gossypii* at the place of production have been observed during the last complete vegetation cycle (since the beginning of the cycle) and a representative sample of the amount has been tested and as a result of such tests they were found to be free from *G. gossypii*)

SUBSIDIARY INFO – Turkey has amended their time limit requirement for the issuance of phytosanitary certificates. The time limit between the inspection date of the commodity and the shipment date of the commodity may be no more than 14 (fourteen) days. Phytosanitary certificates may be issued post departure.
